

FUMC Youth Conduct and Responsibilities

During my time with First United Methodist Church, I will strive for the best possible time and I sign this document as an acceptance of the following responsibilities:

1. Keep myself healthy
I will drink plenty of water and strive to eat properly. (Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner)
I will ensure that I get a sufficient amount of sleep and rest.
2. Maintain a safe environment for others and myself
I agree to be attentive and alert and I will look out for others and myself during the event.
I realize that horsing around could result in a serious injury.
3. Follow the schedule
I agree to participate in all group activities.
I will ensure that I am on time for every event, meeting and pulse check.
I will respect and help with the lights-out schedule.
4. Stay in areas designated
I will stay in a group of three (minimal) at all times.
I will not leave the event or lodging location without permission of the Youth Minister.
I understand that no guys are allowed in the "Females Only" areas and girls are not allowed in the "Male's Only" areas.
5. Respect other's property
I will respect everyone's personal property by not tampering with it or taking it.
I understand that I am personally responsible for any damage done to any property.
6. Sustain a clean environment
I will do my part to keep the location of event and/or lodging clean.
I will not litter or leave trash in the vehicles we are traveling in.
At the end of the event, I will help to clean all vehicles used for transportation.
7. Christ-like attitude and language
At all times, I will display a Christ-like attitude toward my peers, hosts, leaders, chaperones, and the other customers at hotels and restaurants. I will not use profanity.
8. No Public Display of Affection
No holding hands, no hugging, no kissing, etc.
I will strive to make everyone feel included in every aspect of the trip or event.
I understand that this is a time dedicated to the Lord and fellowship with one another.
9. Alterations of personal appearance
I will not make any changes to my personal appearance, while on any youth trip or event.
This includes haircuts, hair coloring, tattoos, and any sort of body piercing.
10. Prohibited Items
I will refrain from using any tobacco products, alcoholic beverages, and non-prescription drugs.
The possession of firearms, knives, and fireworks are prohibited.
